A Schmah Science Workshop was created to EXPLODE the myth of science as a dry, dull subject. Through the leadership of an executive and a student board as well as a network of supporters from the local scientific community, thousands of elementary through high school students in Silicon Valley have directly benefited from the Schmah Science Workshop experience. Our students discover that science is an everlasting hands-on adventure, in which imagination and creativity can enable young people to have fun as they apply the scientific process, learn core scientific principles and make exciting new discoveries on their own.

Fee \$195 per student per Camp

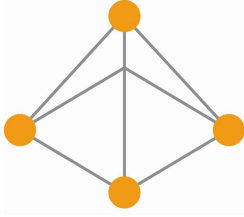
June 22 - June 26: UP, UP AND AWAY - Come spread your wings and fly with us as we explore the mechanics of flight and the physics of air. Students build and launch water, paper and glider rockets, airplanes, gliders and helicopters, and create their own hot air balloons.

June 29 - July 3: THINGS THAT MOVE - SSW kids get moving by building cars that move by rubber bands, balloons, mousetraps, spinners, motors and propellers.

July 13 - 17: MYTHBUSTERS - Modeled after the popular television series, students in this workshop will tackle some of the most common urban legends. Students bust up some of nature's biggest myths! Use tools and technology to investigate some of nature's most intriguing questions. Then separate nature's truths from legend by collecting data, clues, and information along the way. Decide what is fact or fiction at the end of each exciting day.

July 20 - 24: SURVIVE ON SCIENCE WEEK - You are lost on Inquiry Isle...Do you have the skills needed to survive? Discover how to build a shelter, cook using the sun, navigate the unknown with a compass, perform first aid, make arrows for hunting, and purify your own drinking water.

July 27 - 31: LEONARDO da VINCI SCIENCE - Students will become engineers in the tradition of Leonardo da Vinci as they build clocks, take apart gadgets, design submarines, build rockets, learn about lenses and light, construct trebuchets, drop parachutes, make pinhole cameras, dissect squid and cow eyes, and explore anamorphic art.

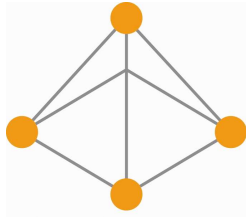
